The third - and possibly final, we'll see - book on the topic of Total Rewards (that is, what I do for the money that pays the bills) was recently published. Hooray!




A youth spent bustling in minimum wage jobs and busking on the streets does not typically add up to a life in corporate roles, but then again . . . not many things are very typical these days!




## MARKETING CHALLENGE

Any ideas? Send 'em my way!




## FLASHBACK: OCCAM'S RAZOR - THAT ONE STAR MISSING FROM THE BIG DIPPER
